What do the numbers mean?

The Estuary Macrofauna Score is based on the composition of the macrofaunal community and tells us how impacted the monitored site is by mud (via a Mud Benthic Health Model). The calculated scores are continuous and represent a gradient of impact. Low scores indicate low impacts from mud (good health), whereas high scores indicate high impact (poor health).

Mud content refers to the amount of fine silt and clay particles (collectively called 'mud') that are present in the estuary sandflats.

The closest monitoring station to Queen Mary Ave is Whau Upper


